Appendix G - Package Descriptions

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Other descriptors (i.e. color, courier, etc...) may be used if necessary.

sbakit = sealed blood alcohol kit
bakit = unsealed blood alcohol kit

se = sealed envelope
sye = sealed yellow envelope
swe = sealed white envelope
e = unsealed envelope
ye = unsealed yellow envelope
we = unsealed white envelope

sbox = sealed box
swbox = sealed white box
box = unsealed box

sbottle = sealed bottle
bottle = unsealed bottle

splb = sealed plastic bag
plb = unsealed plastic bag

scup = sealed cup
cup = unsealed cup

sbpb = sealed brown paper bag
swpb = sealed white paper bag
bpb = unsealed brown paper bag
wpb = unsealed white paper bag

scyl = sealed cylinder
cyl = unsealed cylinder

Because container for evidence packaging can vary, a 's' will be used before the package description to indicate that the package is properly sealed.

If the package is not properly sealed, it will be documented as such; however, the package will be properly sealed before storing in the PEV.

The number of packages received will be documented with the description of the evidence packaging.
